The Southeast Metropolitan Planning Organization (SEMPO) has released a draft of the Regional Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan for public comment. The SEMPO Regional Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan is the first plan in Southeast Missouri specifically focused on coordinated regional planning of non-motorized transportation systems such as bicycle facilities, trails, and sidewalks.
